

School Profile

Wadena-Deer Creek High School has a 2012-2013 enrollment of 600 students in grades 5-12. Our varied curriculum offers a wide range of courses. This allows students to take more courses in areas where they have more interest, which can lead to courses with a higher level of difficulty. Some of the courses with a higher level of difficulty offered at Wadena-Deer Creek (WDC) High School include calculus, trigonometry, physics, and two courses in chemistry. To meet the needs of all students, WDC also offers college level courses (in which college credit is received) in mathematics, science, English and social studies. The college courses in the core areas include a four digit course number on our transcripts.

2 in Fine Arts (Art and/or Music)

Students are also required to pass the MN competencies in reading, math, and written composition.

Credits and Grades

Wadena-Deer Creek High School offers 14/credits year and 7/semester on a 7 period day schedule. A 2 credit course at WDC is the equivalent to one school year.

Wadena-Deer Creek High School uses an unweighted 4.0 grading scale.
